Settle and Attermire Scar

Distance: 6km (4 miles)

Barriers

Parking: several car parks in Settle

Other transport: direct trains from Leeds and Skipton

Toilets: Settle car park

Refreshments: shops, cafes and pubs in Settle

Route description

Constitution Hill – Banks Lane – footpath to Attermire – Victoria cave – Gorbeck – Banks lanekm (2 miles)

Leave Settle by going up Constitution Hill which is on the north side of the market square. This climbs at first then turns left and becomes level. Take the path to the right signed Pennine Bridleway. This is followed along a walled lane and then through fields to a tarmac road.

Turn right, still signed Pennine Bridleway and follow a well made track. Shortly after a gate take the path to the right signed to Victoria Cave. This path skirts Attermire Scar. When you reach a footpath crossroads, turn right, and after a short climb descend down to rejoin the route you followed out of Settle. Turn left to return to the town.
